Children’s Time with the Pastor

Hear these words from the Exodus of the Hebrews (24:12:18, NRSV)

The Lord said to Moses, “Come to me on the mountain, and wait there; and I will give you tablets of stone with the law and the commandments which I’ve written for the people’s instruction.

Moses and his assistant Joshua went up the mountain and a cloud covered the mountain and the glory of the Lord settled on Mount Sinai for six days. On the seventh day, God called to Moses out of the cloud. The appearance of the glory was like a devouring fire in the sight of the people of Israel, and Moses entered the cloud for forty days and forty nights.



And from Peter’s second letter to the early Christians (3:13-18, NIV, read as indicated)



We didn’t follow cleverly devised stories when we told you about the coming of Jesus Christ in power, but we were eyewitnesses of his majesty.

Men: *Jesus received God’s honor and glory when the voice came to him from Glory, saying, “This is my Son, whom I love; with him I’m well pleased.”*

Women: *We ourselves heard his voice that came from heaven when we were with him on the sacred mountain.*

We have this prophetic message as something completely reliable, and you’ll do well to pay attention to it, as to a light shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts.
